The definition of the term 'Disability' in chapter I of the Rights of the Persons with Disability Act, 2016.

Objectives of the Policy:

and syndrome, invisible disabilities, such as psychological and emotional disorders, learning disabilities, heart disease, diabetes, asthma, arthritis, epilepsy, Acquired Brain Injuries (ABI), and Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) are also included in the term 'disability'. Many disabilities vary in degree and type of limitation; therefore, accommodations must also vary and should be tailored to the needs of the individual.

Right of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 prohibits discrimination against individuals with physical and mental disabilities.
